<p>Other relevant information</p> <p>AMSA has an informal appeal process which is that any decision relating to port State control may be appealed in writing to the Manager Ship Inspection as soon as possible from the time of the decision. Upon receipt of an informal appeal, AMSA will acknowledge receipt and commence an investigation. Depending on the complexity of the matter and workload at the time, it may take up to 20 business days to complete a thorough investigation and provide a detailed response to the applicant.</p> <p>The formal National appeal process is that a person affected by a decision relating to port State control may, subject to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975, apply to the Australian Administrative Appeals Tribunal (AAT) for a review of the decision. This</p>

appeal must generally be made within 28 days of the appealed decision being made.
The master of the vessel is advised of the appeal procedure upon conclusion of the inspection.
This procedure is also printed on the back of the detention notification handed to the master
when a vessel is detained.

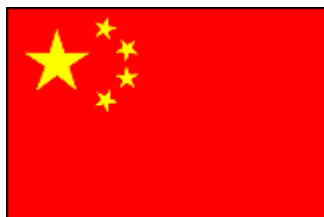

<p>Other relevant information</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • According to DIRECTEMAR Circular 0-71/004, decisions concerning PSC detentions can be appealed in writing, and the claim document can be addressed by the ship master directly to the Port State Control Officer or to the Local Maritime Authority in the port of detention (Capitán de Puerto). Procedure is handed over to the Master at the beginning of the inspection. • If the result of the decision taken by the Local Maritime Authority, is negative, the master/owner/operator of a ship has the right of a reconsideration petition against the official notice of denied to the Chilean Maritime Authority (DIRSOMAR / DIRECTEMAR), basis in the Chilean Law, article 15 of the Law 19.880/2003 for the Administrative Proceedings. In both cases, the appeal procedure does not lead the suspension of the detention. • The Flag State (FS) or the Recognized Organization (RO) may ask the Chilean Maritime Authority (DIRSOMAR / DIRECTEMAR) to reconsider the decision to detain the ship. In such case, there will be a deeper investigation, and the outcome will be informed to the FS or the RO.

- If the FS or the RO disagrees with the outcome, a request for review may be sent to the Tokyo MOU or Viña del Mar Agreement Secretariats within 120 days from the date of release of the detention. Such a request should be accompanied by all information relevant to the detention in electronic format (E-mail) and in the English language.

<p>Detention Appeal Procedures in China</p> <p>1. In accordance with national administrative review regulations, appeal against the decision of detention could be made to the related regional MSA offices (totally 14), which cover certain port offices which deliver the notice of the detention, within 60 days from the date of detention. The regional MSA office, taking the responsibility of supervising the quality of PSC inspections, will examine and make decision on the appeal within 60 days from the date of acceptance of the appeal.</p> <p>In the case of the appeal-maker does not accept the decision made by the regional MSA office, it might forward the appeal to the head office for reviewing again.</p> <p>The appeal might also be forwarded to the head office of China MSA directly. Generally, however, the appeal will be transferred to the regional MSA in charge for initial reviewing before the head office returning its decision to the qualified appeal-maker.</p>

2. In the case of the party concerned disagreed with the decision of the administrative review, the appeal may be brought to a People's Court in accordance with the national laws.

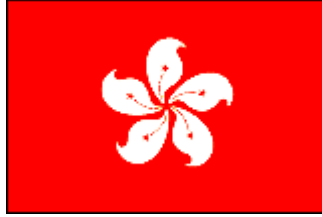

<u>Procedures to seek review of detention of ship</u>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> When a ship in Hong Kong waters is detained by Marine Department Port State Control Officer(s) on the ground that the ship is unsafe to proceed to sea and/or fails to comply with the applicable international convention requirement(s), the master or owner of the ship may, if believing that the ship has been unduly detained, request the Marine Department to review the detention. 3. The master or owner will be informed in writing of the decision of review within (14) days upon receipt of the request for the review of detention.

Appeal Procedures

The right of appeal is contained in the Merchant Shipping (Safety) Ordinance, Cap. 369 and Merchant Shipping (Court of Survey) Regulations, Cap. 369A.

If the master or owner of a ship is aggrieved by the decision of the Marine Department to detain the ship, the concerned master or owner may appeal against the decision to a Court of Survey in accordance with the Merchant Shipping (Court of Survey) Regulation. However, the lodging of such an appeal shall not cause the detention to be suspended.

The appeal shall be lodged by filing with the Director of Marine a notice in the form as prescribed in the Merchant Shipping (Court of Survey) Regulation.

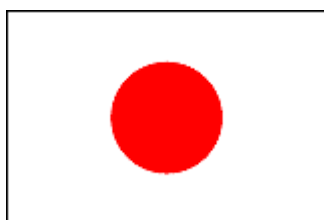

The Master, Ship Owner, ISM Operators, and Flag States may address their appeals/complaints to the specific PSC Center (District PSC Office) where the inspection transpired or directly to the National Port State Control Service (National PSC Head Office). Assessment will be made at these levels, and recommendation (when necessary) will be forwarded to the National Headquarters Philippine Coast Guard (Attn: Office of the Deputy Chief of Coast Guard Staff for Maritime Safety Services, CG-8) for evaluation and/or approval.

The appeal must be made in writing, with specifying arguments and facts or legal references. However the appeal does not prevent the enforcement of the detention order. The PSCO shall consider the appeal and notify the appellant without delay but not more than thirty days from the date of receiving the appeal. In the case of agreeing to the appeal, whether in whole or in part, the detention order shall be changed without delay. If the PSCO do not agree with the appeal, whether in whole or in part, they should rapidly report with the reason to the Director of Ship Standard Bureau. The Director of Ship Standard Bureau shall complete its consideration of the appeal within thirty days from the date of receiving the report. If there is a necessity, it cannot be considered within the said period. The Director of Ship Standard Bureau shall notify the appellant in writing before the expiration of the period. Therefore, the time for the appeal can be extended for thirty days the results of scrutiny make by the Director of Ship Standard Bureau are considered.</p>
